

#### SAGRADA FAMILIA – INCLUDING FAST TRACK ENTRY

We this ticket because... you don't waste time standing in queues to visit this iconic masterpiece – skip the line with our fast track entry ticket! Everyone visiting Barcelona will want to visit the Sagrada Familia cathedral – so make sure you pre-book your ticket to avoid long queues.

- A guided tour of the Sagrada Familia Gaudi's unfinished masterpiece started in 1882 and expected to be finished in another 80 years!
- Tour runs daily all year round apart from November where it runs Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays and lasts approximately 1 ½ hours
- After the official guided tour you can enjoy a visit to the Towers (at your own leisure)
- Tour starts and finishes outside the Sagrada (Plaza Sagrada Familia No.3)
- Correct dress code is required tank tops, strapless tops, short shorts or sandals are not acceptable.



#### CAMP NOU EXPERIENCE WITH SKIP THE LINE ENTRY

We this ticket because... this popular attraction gets really busy so it makes good sense to take advantage of our skip the line entry ticket to avoid wasting precious holiday time. Plus don't forget our tickets are gate ready too!

- Ticket includes access to the changing rooms, tunnel, commentary boxes and the Camp Nou museum
- Tickets must be used on the date they are booked for and can be collected up to 3 days in advance from the office situated just off Las Ramblas
- Visit begins on the first floor of the museum, a large modern, interactive museum that takes you through the history of FC Barcelona, explaining the values that have made Barca 'more than a club'
- You will then enter the visitors' changing rooms and the tunnel leading onto the pitch
- You can also visit the television studio, the mixed zone, the press room and the commentary boxes – a dream for any football fan!

- 72 Hour Barcelona Transport Card offering 3 days of UNLIMITED TRAVEL around the city via bus, metro, tram including train to and from the airport!

### **BARCELONA AQUARIUM**

We this ticket because... this is the largest Mediterranean-themed aquarium in the world – definitely worth a visit (especially if you have children!)

- Located within easy walking distance of Las Ramblas its one of the most visited tourist attractions in the city
- The large aquarium hosts Europe's best reproduction of the waters and inhabitants of the Mediterranean, with 21 tanks containing specially selected species from all over the planet
- An impressive 80 metre long tunnel that surrounds the Oceanarium will give you a close-up view of many sharks
- There is also a large, interactive area for kids that will teach them more about sea creatures, fossils, penguins, sea horses, and much more
- With 11,000 organisms and 450 different species this really is another world!

#### LAS GOLONDRINAS BOAT TRIP

We this ticket because... it's a fascinating way to enjoy views of the Barcelona coastline from one of these iconic pleasure boat experiences. Book in advance and save money off resort prices!

- Sail takes approximately 1 ½ hours and takes you 9 miles along the seafront of Barcelona, beaches and ports
- Departs from Portal de la Pau Square (next to Drassanes Docks, in front of the Columbus Statue)
- Trip operates year round although less availability in the winter months







### DAY TRIP TO PORTAVENTURA WORLD

We this ticket because... it allows you to enjoy a full day at Spain's best-loved theme park – without even sitting behind a wheel! (Round-trip transportation included)

- Allow 12 hours for this trip. Journey time being approximately 1 ½ hours each way
